Distance/Access to Project: 3.3 miles - hike – To get to the Apgar Lookout Trailhead, look for a paved road about 200 yards north of the West Entrance to Glacier National Park which is known as the Apgar Horse Corral Road. When you reach a "Y" in the road across from outfitter barn stay left towards the Quarter Circle Bridge. About 1.5 miles beyond this bridge on a gravel road, you will see the Apgar Lookout Trailhead sign.
