Location:

Cabinet Ranger District Kootenai National Forest Star Peak Lookout is a 10 mile lightly trafficked out and back trail located near Heron, Montana.

Coordinates – 48.068868, -115.924948

Elevation - 3,917'

<u>Project Dates:</u> Late July Target – Decided on my project crew.

<u>Project:</u> Phase two of a comprehensive restoration project which will include replacing the windows which are being refurbished offsite, installing new shutters, scraping, and painting.

<u>Number of Volunteers</u> – 2-3 (If you sign up for this project, you will be placed on a volunteer backup list as last year's crew is scheduled to finish this project this summer.)

Volunteer Skills: Carpentry/Building, Home maintenance, i.e., scraping, sanding, and painting.

<u>Distance/Access to Project</u> – <u>Directions to Trailhead</u>: The trailhead is just off Montana Highway 200, 45 miles east of Sandpoint, ID and 45 miles West of Thompson Falls, MT. The trailhead turn-off is near mile marker 6.5 on Forest Road #2292. About 100 yards up the road, there is a switchback and the trail head is in that corner. It's marked with a brown lath with the number 999 on it. There is room for about four or five cars near the trailhead. Trail distance to lookout is 5 miles with an elevation gain of 4000'
