Location:

Yaak (Kootenai National Forest, Three Rivers Ranger District)

Coordinates – N 48° 57.778' W 115° 58.078'

Elevation – 5236'

Target Dates: July 26-Aug 1 – May be an overnight project

Project:

- Remove windows to be refurbished offsite and reinstalled in 2025.
- Assess restoration project which is scheduled for 2025

Distance/Access to Project – The trailhead is approximately twenty miles up the Pete Creek road #338. Pete Creek road starts just a few miles south of Yaak, Montana, on highway #508. - Northwest Peak lookout trail #169 takes you about 2.5 miles to the top with an elevation gain of ~1400 feet.
